International RIBA Competition selects Quattro for a top 5 spot

Quattro Design Architects have been shortlisted in an international design competition run by the RIBA, to create a dramatic and inspirational UK landmark.



“The Wall” is the visionary project of former Leicester City FC Chaplain Richard Gamble, to design a structure using a million bricks, each representing a story of answered prayer. It is intended the winning entry will be built by the side of a motorway, similar to the Angel of the North.

The competition attracted 134 entries from 24 countries, and Quattro were announced as one of the final five at a prestigious event held at Westminster. The judging panel includes Renato Benedetti, acting as RIBA advisor, the Rt Hon Stephen Timms MP, Baroness Sal Brinton and BBC TV Songs of Praise presenter Pam Rhodes.

Quattro’s aim was to develop a soaring wall and a defined space, without creating a physical barrier. Perceived as an ellipse or a circle dependent on the angle of view, each one of these aspects lends themselves to being appreciated as an allegory responding to the visitor’s personal perspective, and as a circle can be perceived as the offering of a prayer with the return of a supplied answer.

Andy Tansill, Director at Quattro said: “We are delighted for the Team to have their work appreciated by this eminent judging panel. The design was created by a group of six, who came together from across the Practice and collaborated to emerge with an inspiring solution – Well Done”.
