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Gloucester Architects Lead the Way in RIBA International Competition

Gloucester based Quattro Design Architects have been long-listed in an international design competition run by the RIBA, to create a dramatic and inspirational UK landmark.



“The Wall” is the visionary project of former Leicester City FC Chaplain, Richard Gamble, to design a structure using a million bricks, each representing a story of answered prayer. It is intended the winning entry will be built by the side of a motorway, similar to the Angel of the North.

Quattro are recognised nationally for their work across a broad range of sectors - locally they are currently working on the redevelopment of Shire Hall and the flagship-housing scheme on the former Kwik Save site at Black Dog Way.

Dan Christison of Quattro said, “We are delighted to have been long-listed in this international competition. We saw this as an exciting opportunity for us to challenge ourselves to create something outside our usual design work. We are really proud of our achievement and will be waiting with anticipation to see if we make it to the next stage”.

A shortlist of 5 designs will be announced in Westminster, London on 7th February 2017, at the launch of the UK touring exhibition.
